Background Information

A tribute to the brand's history, named after one of Leasingham's four founders, solicitor Magnus Badger. But the wine is also attributable to the distinctive characteristics of the Clare Valley, using fruit sourced from the region we have always proudly called home.

Tasting Notes

Deep ruby red, this wine displays lifted aromas of raspberries, mocha and black pepper spice.

With vibrant and expressive fruit, the palate shows flavours of red berries and chocolate. Balanced by juicy acidity, this Shiraz has fleshy sweetness and mouth filling lingering tannins.

Winemaker's Notes

The Magnus Shiraz is a new extension to the Leasingham range that is named after one of the founders of this historic winery. The wine shows all the hallmarks of Clare Valley reds, with expressive flavour and a full rich structure. Generous and honest, a reflection of one of Australia's premier Shiraz regions.
